

COMMUNITY SAFETY CHARTER

Thompson, Manitoba

By signing the Community Safety Charter you commit to assuming your share of the responsibility in helping to achieve the common target of reducing crime, saving lives and making our community safer. This commitment is your opportunity to decide upon which community safety initiatives you would like to carry out over the next three years. For example, as an individual you could choose to install proper lighting around your home; as a business you could create a Drug Free Zone; and as an organization you could know your resources.

The commitment could:

- Be concrete, tangible and able to be monitored.
- Contribute directly or indirectly in the areas of the goals of reducing crime, saving lives and/or making our community safer.
- Go beyond what you are obliged to do by law.
- Have a two year duration with follow up in six months.
- The commitment should outline key measures on how to achieve the target.

As a signatory of the Community Safety Charter you will be exchanging good practices throughout Thompson; helping and inspiring others to carry out more actions that will make our community safer, while at the same time helping to encourage healthy homes, healthy communities and building cultural pride.
